What is a Service Unit?

Service units are the local group of Girl Scout members and include all of the troops, girls, volunteers, and community members in a geographic area.

A team of volunteers leads each service unit and collaborates with council staff to coordinate events for girls, manage the fall product and cookie programs, provide volunteer support and recognition, and support membership growth and Girl Scout visibility.

Service units hold regular meetings for volunteers in the area to get to know each other, find support and ideas, and stay informed with local Girl Scout events and opportunities.

All volunteers are welcome to attend meetings and each troop should have at least one volunteer present at each meeting.
